# Middleton Parish Council Chairman's Report

There is not a great deal to report from the latest Parish Council(PC) meetings as many items are still on-going.

The redundant telephone box at The Gate was refurbished and painted in the traditional red paint being supplied by Cllr. V Ward. At some time after the painting, persons unknown painted the roof black. The PC had discussed repainting it red but has now decided to leave it as is. There are no plans to paint the redundant telephone box in Blackborough End as it does not belong to the PC, it belongs to a charity.

The PC welcomed our new Borough Councillor Simon Nash to the meeting. Simon reported that he had several issues with the Borough Council of King's Lynn and West Norfolk (BCKLWN) particularly with accountability and transparency. He hopes to resolve the problems now that he is a Councillor.

The PC agreed to plant a tree within the playing field area and if this is successful they would plant some more.

The Speed Watch team are still recording high incidents of speeding. In one location within one hour, 71 cars were recorded as exceeding the speed limit. From feedback the PC is receiving, it appears some residents living in the parish assume it is their prerogative to exceed the speed limit. Perhaps they should reflect on what would happen if their speeding results in an accident and in the worst scenario a fatality.

The Parish Clerk reported that Highways have visited the junction of Station Road and the A47. It is agreed that the situation is unsatisfactory but there is little that can be done at the present time.

The PC are still considering purchasing a defibrillator but are awaiting a demonstration to be carried out before making a decision. If a defibrillator is purchased it has been agreed that it will be installed at the Village Hall.

There has been an incident of vandalism at the playing field. This is a shame as a few are spoiling it for the majority of users.

Open Churches Week Usually the diocese of Norwich has an Open Churches Week which many churches participate in. Sadly, this isn't happening this year, but East Winch has decided to have its own. 

## East Winch Parish Council Meeting 8th July

Our meeting was attended by one of the new Borough councillors for the Grimston and Gayton Ward (that's us), Councillor Colin Manning.

It was reported that the RSPCA Hospital had purchased a defibrillator. The Council agreed to pay for the heated box to keep it in and to get estimates for installation and electricity connection.

Although the clearing of the dyke outside Station Terrace is on the Rangers' list of activities nothing appears to have been done.

There are at present 8 Speedwatch volunteers, though not all are in good health, and therefore other offers to help will be welcome. Application forms are being processed by the police. Michael Stent is the Co-ordinator.

A parishioner complained that the right of way across the field towards Grandcourt was impassible because of the potato crop. Since the meeting, Sibelco has been contacted about this.

Cllr. Manning told the meeting something about himself and the Borough Council's plans for the Guildhall. He is on the Planning Committee, and did not want to get involved with our discussions about planning applications, so that he has an open mind at planning committee meetings.

We have got the go-ahead from John Hussey of the Borough Council to buy the bench and table we wanted for the playground. Mr Hussey had also recommended where to put it, and the meeting agreed it could go between the swings and boundary fence. It was also noted that a new group, The Friends of East Winch and West Bilney, were intending to fundraise for new equipment. The Clerk advised the Council that there might be a grey area as to who should maintain it once installed, and that a meeting would be helpful.

A Borough Council consultation re the

temporary removal and redirection of the right of way across the field to Grandcourt was considered. The Council had nothing new to add. For members of the public who wish to comment, the reference is C/2/2018/2016: comments to be received by 1st August. By a majority, the Council voted not to object to Planning application 19/01086/F re Bilney Barns.

Highways - The clerk reported that the assessors have not decided how much the Council should receive in insurance payment for the bus shelter. His attempts to communicate are ignored.

Concrete waste dumped near the phone box hasn't been removed. Cllr Manning was asked to help with getting a response from Highways about the broken posts on the trod, as numerous requests have not been responded to.

The next meeting will be on Monday, 2nd September at 7.30.




