NEW FORMULA FOR MIDDLETON HALL GOLF CLUB

The new owners of Middleton Hall Golf Club, Dave & Fatna Freeman, have swapped the high-octane world of Formula 1 to start their new venture here in Middleton.

Dave trained as a chef in the British Army before setting up a very successful business providing high quality catering services to F1 teams. Over nearly 25 years he worked for several teams, but mainly with Honda and so Japanese cuisine became a speciality.

He was part of two F1 Championship winning teams, once with Jenson Button and last year with Max Verstappen. But his best prize in F1 was meeting and marrying Fatna with whom his business became the best in the pit lane.

They decided it was time for change. Dave is a keen golfer and so combining golf with high quality hospitality seemed to be the perfect solution.

Dave said: "We looked at a few golf courses, but Middleton Hall was the best of the bunch as it is a beautiful, well-established course with great potential to develop our hospitality business."

Since taking over in March, Dave and Fatna have lost no time getting to work. The Clubhouse quickly received a full refurbishment and a new Function Suite with capacity to seat up to 130 guests has been built in part of the former car park. It has its own catering facilities, a stage for live music and a 15 metre video wall. There is a full glass wall on one side providing guests with panoramic views over the golf course.

Dave said: "Our aim is to make Middleton Hall a premier venue in Norfolk for both golf and hospitality events. The Clubhouse will serve great food to golfers and to local people. During the summer months, we are replacing the traditional Sunday lunch with a BBQ offering a range of tasty dishes.

The Function Suite will be the focus for larger events such as conferences or special family occasions.

We start with the Queen's Platinum Jubilee when we will host a Derby Day party with live band on Saturday, 4 June followed by a Platinum Jubilee Street Party on Sunday, 5 June with a Chas & Dave tribute band, hog roast barbeque and fun for the children."

East Winch Parish Council Meetings 16 May 2022

At the Annual Parish Meeting, Mr Mel Place and Mr Alan Yarham were re-elected as Chair and Vice-Chair respectively of the Parish Council for 2022/23. In his annual report for 2021/22, the Chair noted the important input that the Parish Council made into planning matters, highlighting its objections to the proposed Wellness Resort at Ashwicken and the proposed Holiday and Recreation Site development at Pentney Woods. However, the Parish Council was not able to get involved in individual planning disputes between neighbours; these had to be referred to the Borough Council. During the year the Parish Council successfully secured the funds needed to make the Trod to Ashwicken Road, with the support of Jim Moriarty our County Councillor. We await a starting date for the Trod works from Highways. There remains one vacancy on the Parish Council - the Chair encouraged anyone interested to contact the Clerk (bob.pannell1@btinternet.com). Meantime the financial accounts for the Parish Council were in a healthy position.

Nell Steele gave the East Winch and West Bilney Church Report. The Parochial Church Council had agreed to increase the number of days that East Winch Church will be open: going forward it will be open 10am-4pm on Wednesdays, Saturdays and Sundays. West Bilney Church is a redundant church which normally holds three services a year; the next service to be held there will be on 26 June at 6pm. West Bilney Church can host one event (eg a concert or an exhibition) a year. Any ideas would be welcome.

Paula Blowers gave a report on the Village Hall. Although the Hall made a loss in 2020/21, its bank balances are healthy, various improvement works were undertaken in 2021, and a new website and the installation of wifi are planned for 2022.

Keith Harrod reported on East Winch United Charities (210684). The Charity owns four parcels of land – allotments for the use of parishioners and agricultural land (the rent from which is donated as grants to needy parishioners, to the Parish Church, and to local organisations existing for the benefit of residents). There are allotment plots available. If they are not worked, the land may have to be rented out for agricultural use and then they will not be available for allotment use again in the near future. So, vegetable growers, use them or lose them!

At the Parish Council meeting that followed, reports were received from our County Councillor, Jim Moriarty and from our Borough Councillors, Michael De Whalley and Colin Manning.

Key points from the meeting were:

- No news yet on the Sibelco appeal to the Secretary of State regarding their application to start excavating Min 40. More might be known after the liaison meeting at the end of the month.
- There was no date yet for consideration of the Wellness Resort application at the Borough Council's Planning Committee. Concerns were expressed that should planning be granted construction traffic might access the site via Gayton Road in the village, and that the Parish Council needed to be alert to this.
- Ideas were sought for new purposes for the Hoechst Cup (originally awarded to the overall winner of the annual village "Frolic" event).

The next PC meeting will be on 4th July at 7.30.

Occasionally, there will be other services as well: on 26th June an evening service at West Bilney and on 10th July the North Runcton Flower Festival service at 6.30. Both very enjoyable for different reasons.






